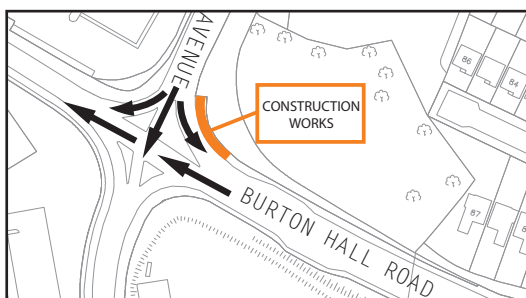
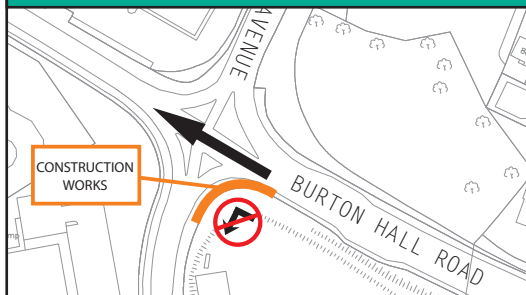


Works during 26/10/07 - 04/11/07



Works ongoing until early October

Utilities Diversions

Blackthorn Avenue Area.

Utilities Diversions Work (water, gas, electricity, telecoms, etc) on Blackthorn Avenue were delayed due to unforeseen site conditions and extra works. We apologise for any inconvenience this may have caused. These works are due to be completed in early October. For safety reasons and to facilitate the remaining works the current traffic restrictions will remain in place.

Burton Hall Road

It is proposed that the remainder of the utilities diversions works on Burton Hall Road will be carried out during the Mid-term break from 26th October until 04th November. Traffic management for these works is currently being agreed with the relevant authorities. It is envisaged that Burton Hall Road will be reduced to a single inbound lane into the industrial estate for the duration of the works. We will confirm the traffic management arrangements closer to the start date.

Ballyogan Road

Work on the upgrading of Ballyogan Road is ongoing. Two way traffic flow will be maintained at all times.

Health and safety

For your safety road and footpath cleaning is carried out throughout the day.

For safety reasons we request that cars, pedestrians and cyclists follow signposted diversion routes.

Bridges

New Luas Bridge over M50 at Junction 15 Carrickmines

Construction of the Luas Bridge over the M50 at Junction 15 has progressed significantly. The traffic management arrangements in place are running smoothly. It is proposed to erect the bridge deck beams (over the M50 carriageway) before the end of the year. To facilitate these operations, M50 traffic will be rerouted between Junction 16 (Cherrywood) and Junction 14 (Sandyford) via the N11.

New Luas Bridge over M50 at Junction 14 Leopardstown

Construction of the Luas Bridge structure is going well. Two lanes of traffic will be maintained at all times during the works.

New Luas Bridge over Brewery Road / Leopardstown Road Roundabout

The construction of the bridge pier on the roundabout is progressing well. Once the pier is complete, the bridge deck beams will be lifted into place. Due to the fact that the placing of the beams will entail local road closures, proposals are being developed to carry out the necessary works during off peak periods to minimise disruption. Further details will be provided prior to the commencement of the works.

Glenamuck Bridge and Road Works

Works are ongoing and progressing well. The temporary pedestrian pathway in place will be realigned as the works progress.

New Luas Cherrywood Viaduct

Good progress has been made on the construction of the new Luas viaduct at Cherrywood either side of Wyattville Link Road. Proposals for traffic management arrangements to allow construction of the section of the viaduct across the road are currently being developed. It is hoped to implement these traffic management arrangements in early November. Further details will be communicated in future updates.
