The Railway Procurement Agency (RPA) is developing plans for the proposed new Luas Line that will run from St. Stephen's Green through the city centre to Broombridge - Luas Line BXD. This new Luas Line will link the Luas Red and Green Lines; provide access to the new unified DIT campus facility planned for Grangegorman; and interchange with the Maynooth suburban rail line services at Broombridge.

RPA is currently preparing an application for a Railway Order for Line BXD which, if granted, will provide the necessary powers to construct, operate and maintain the line.

In recent months RPA has displayed the BXD proposals for the city centre section from St. Stephen's Green to Broadstone.

This next display of BXD plans is now focussed on the final section from Broadstone to Broombridge along the former Broadstone railway cutting. The arrangements for the display are as follows:
