Georges Dock bridge works are progressing well and access arrangements for vehicles and pedestrians will remain as they are for the foreseeable future. For safety reasons we request that cyclists dismount when using the pedestrian walkway.

Utilities Diversions on Mayor Street

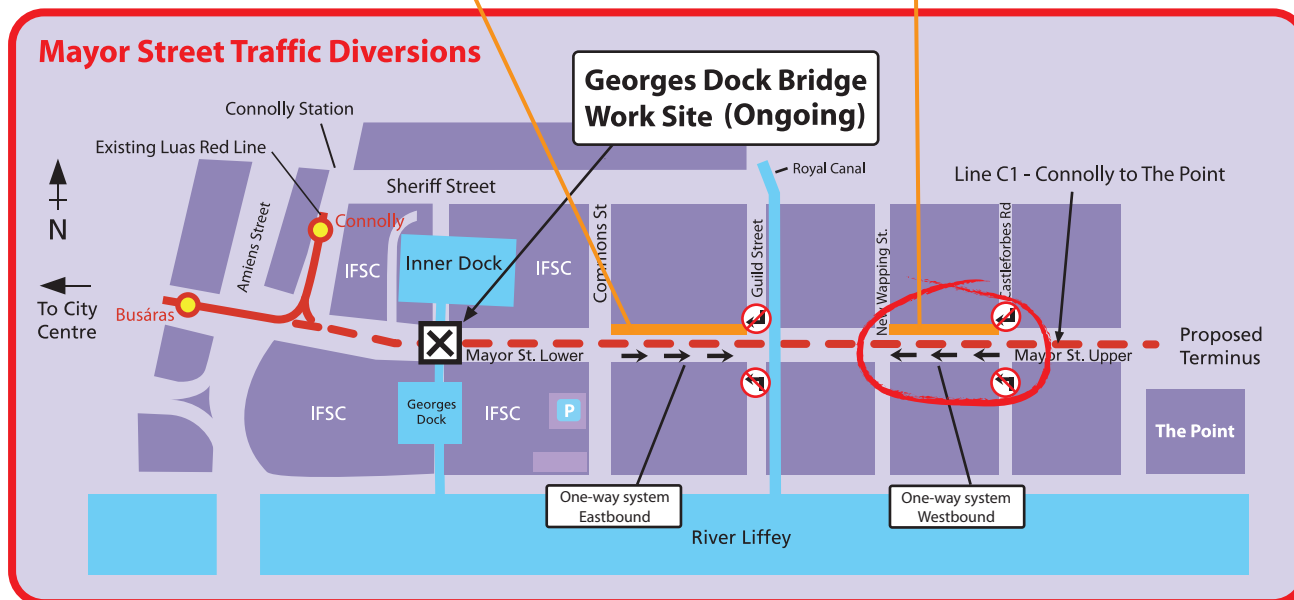
The diversion of utilities on Mayor Street Upper and Lower is due to start in week commencing, 9th of July 2007 for approximately seven months. These works will involve the excavation of sections of the footpath and the road in the following areas.

The footpath outside La Touche House on the corner of Mayor Street Lower and Amiens Street will be closed. For your safety, please follow the signs indicating the revised pedestrian routes.

Mayor Street Lower between Commons Street and Guild Street will be reduced to one lane and a one-way system will be in operation to facilitate the works on the North side of the street.

Traffic will be directed from Commons Street eastward onto Guild Street. Loading access will be provided, however the on street pay and display parking will be removed.

Mayor Street Upper between New Wapping Street and Castleforbes Road will be reduced to one lane and a one-way **westbound** system will be in operation



Changing Streetscape

As part of the Luas extension to The Point the streetscape in the area will change. RPA contractors will need to clear some trees but we are committed to planting additional trees in the Docklands area once construction is complete. The cobble stones on Mayor Street Lower will be taken up and stored for reuse later as part of the final design.

All Luas projects are finished to a high architectural specifications and the new streetscape will reflect this commitment. Wherever possible the historic character and heritage of the streetscape will be retained.
