Press Release - Temporary Closure of 2 Luas Stops

The Railway Procurement Agency has advised Luas customers that the Red Line stops at Busaras and Connolly Station will be temporarily closed from Monday June 16th until early Autumn. Abbey Street Stop, which has recently been upgraded will be the temporary terminus for Luas Red Line services. This is to facilitate the on-going construction of the new Luas Docklands Line which is due to commence services in 2009. RPA has recently awarded the contract for the installation of the Luas track and related Luas infrastructure. These works will involve the installation of a new Luas Tramwork system at Amiens Street and Mayor Street. This new junction will allow trams coming from Busaras to go to Connolly or to go directly to Docklands. It is necessary to close Connolly and Busaras Luas stops to complete these works.

The temporary closure of Connolly and Busaras stops does not affect the rest of the Luas Red Line. Operating times and frequency of trams will not change.

The Docklands Line (Luas Line C1) is the extension of the Luas Red Line (Connolly-Tallaght) to the Point. New stops will be provided at George's Dock, Mayor Square, Spencer Dock and the Point.
